

## TREA Virtual Show General Rules

USDF rules are followed.

Only a total of three tests can be ridden, per horse and rider combination.

No coaching during tests, reading tests is allowed.

Please do not play music in video, normal back ground sounds only.

Helmets must be worn. Neat attire is acceptable, show clothing is not required.

Filming must be clear, horizontal filming is best. Showing the whole arena is preferable but zooming when the rider is at the far end of the arena is okay. Videos are filmed from C where the judge would be sitting.

Videos cannot be resubmitted to TREA Virtual Shows.

State the name of rider, test ridden and date after the final salute.

Dark, blurry videos that do not clearly portray the horse and rider will not be judged.

Upload videos to You Tube or another file sharing site. Apply links to show entry.

All entries are non refundable after closing date.

Late entries are accepted within three days of closing date for an additional fee.

Shows may be extended, per organizers request.

All ribbons and prizes can be picked up at Coventry Equestrian Center or mailed to applicant. Additional fees required, see entry form.

Results will be posted, emailed and shared on TREA's facebook page within 4 weeks of show s closing date.

First Level test two and lower can be ridden in a small arena (20 x 40 meters). Tests above First Level Test Two should be ridden in a large or standard arena (20 x 60 meters). Level grass arenas are acceptable as long as arena dimensions are shown via the letter placement.

Classes will be divided Open, Adult Amateur, Junior
